Carpark - As I have pointed out before, any carpark (and in particular school car parks) are places where rules seem to go out the window! This includes using the disabled car park spaces. These are reserved for people with the disability exemption card. You must turn left and go around the roundabout. This is a transit NZ requirement and also ensures the safety of anyone walking along the footpath. We have children who walk to school and people leaving the car park need to be aware of this.
