

Middle Syndicate Home Learning Plan

Here are some ideas of how to set your day up if your child is working at home. Please adapt these to suit your circumstances and routine. Each family will have their own way of working through the day. However, it is important to try and keep some structure to the day, and make sure your children are active where possible.



| Time | Activity | Description |
|---------------|---|---|
| Before 9am | Wake up; Morning chores | Get dressed, make bed, tidy room, breakfast |
| 9.00 - 10.00 | Morning Walk; Outside play/activity | Family walk or exercise |
| 10.00 - 11.00 | Scheduled Academic Time (Teachers will be available through email at this time) | A balance of Electronic and non-electronic study Eg: Sudoku, flash cards, board games, reading, Maths, Inquiry tasks (set by school and/or home) |
| 11.00 - 12.00 | Creative Time | Lego; Art; Music; baking etc |
| 12.00 - 1.00 | Lunch & exercise | |
| 1.00 - 2.00 | Chill Time | Reading, puzzles, device if allowed etc |
| 2.00 - 3.30 | Scheduled Academic Time | A balance of Electronic and non-electronic study On-line programme from school, PRIME other maths activities, Reading activities, Spelling, Written Language etc |
