It has been an interesting few weeks since returning to school under level 2. Initially the children were very calm, focused and on task. Lately we have seen some inappropriate behaviours. We know that many children are tired and have a lot on their minds. Can we ask you to support us by reminding your child about the school values and how they relate to a healthy society. We all make mistakes, and that is often how we learn. We recognise that most of our children live by the Values and we also need their help to remind others how important they are.

Child Safety:

Maunu School does not have the ideal environment for dropping off and picking up children. The busy Austin Road can be a real problem at certain times of the day and needs everyone to take extra care. We do have 40kmh speed restrictions, but many people not involved in the school do not respect this. If you feel the need to park on the western side of Austin Road, please do not expect your child to cross the road to get to you - it is just too dangerous. You must come across and get them. I know how distraught we would all be if something happened to a child while they were crossing the road.

The hall car park is also a problem area with its narrow entrance and the volume that comes through it. We have put in place procedures for the end of the day to ensure the safety of children. The children need to wait with the duty teacher and be collected by their parent. We do not want children walking across the car park - they are just too small and do not make the best decisions when faced with a tricky situation.
