The wild and wet Northland weather is certainly with us at this time! It is a good idea to ensure children have a change of clothes and come to school ready to cope with the wind and rain. By keeping dry and warm we can hopefully keep the winter bugs away, but please remember that in these current times if your child is unwell please do not send them to school. The advice we have been given from the Ministries of Education and Health is if they come over to the office with sniffles and coughs we should be sending them home. This can be disruptive for all, so it is best to make the call in the morning. Hopefully we will be through this cold weather soon and we can enjoy some sun and warmth free of winter ills.

## **Covid 19 Level 2 information:**

On Wednesday, at midday, we went back into Level 2. This means there are some restrictions we have to put in place to meet the Ministry of Health guidelines. These include:

**Contact Tracing** - We have the Covid19 QR code around the school for people to use. Anyone coming on site must fill in the contact register in either the classroom or the office whether you use the QR code or not.

Visitors & Parents: School personnel (children and staff) have dispensation with the 2m distancing rule, however parents and visitors must maintain the 2m distance. To manage this, we ask that people only come on site if they need to. It is not that we don't want you here, but we have to know who is here at all times.

Pick Up & Drop Off: Please be extra careful during these times. The school car park continues to be a chaotic place, sometimes made worse by people waiting in their cars and expecting children to cross the car park. With SUVs and other large vehicles this is a recipe for disaster. We have staff on duty in the afternoons, so please respect their directions and advice. Please do not expect your child to cross Austin Road on their own (morning or afternoon). If you park on the far side, you need to cross your child over or come across and get them.

We certainly hope we will be through this in a short period of time. In the meantime, we all need to work together and support each other.

I feel for those businesses that may have to revise their work conditions and again, strongly urge people to **support local**.
