Tena koutou, greetings to you all

Recent events in and around New Zealand have had an impact on everyone and that includes us here at Maunu School. With the guidelines around Level 2, we are unable to hold some events as we would normally do. This included the school cross country. It has also affected some of the planned class and syndicate trips. We have also stopped school assemblies, just to be on the safe side in terms of being super close to each other. While these are all regrettable, they are unavoidable and we just have to think of creative ways to deal with these. This newsletter has important information about up-coming events.

School Cross Country: We would like to thank Pompallier Catholic College for allowing us to use their grounds to design a course for our students. We were able to run our races while their students were in class, thus avoiding any group interactions. Unfortunately, we were unable to have parents on site as that would have meant we had to abide by the Level 2 gathering numbers and distancing. This would have been impossible. We did not make this decision lightly, and with the uncertainty of both weather and Covid19 levels, we chose to run the event as soon as we could. It meant that we have at least been able to hold our cross country for which the children have practiced; we have been able to celebrate all those who competed and we have been able to identify runners who will be able to represent the school at the Whangarei Championships when they are held. These are planned for Wednesday 23 September, as long as we are at level 1. There will be more information provided to those children eligible to compete. Again, I would like to congratulate all children who practiced and then ran their course. We acknowledge that cross country is not for everyone, and the effort put in by all children was amazing. Congratulations to those who were place getters or came in the top 5, making them eligible to represent the school at future events. Covid 19 Level 2 information:

Thank you all for working with us at this time. Contact tracing registers (and the QR Code) are important measures in ensuring NZ is able to deal with any Covid19 situation. Please keep signing the register if you need to come onto the school grounds.

For the next two weeks (until 6th September) we remain in Level 2, so all guidelines remain in place. If we get information that differs or changes anything, we will notify you as soon as possible.

Facemasks: Facemasks are not mandatory at primary schools in Level 2. Anyone who does wear a mask, needs to have been taught how to use it properly so that they are not creating more of a risk than they would without one. We have not heard about masks on school buses at this stage, but anyone using public transport (i.e. the Green buses) must wear a mask from Monday 31 August. Once I hear from the MoE about school bus runs, I will send something out on the school app.

2020 Country Fair: Regrettably, we have decided to cancel the Country Fair for this year. This is a decision made jointly by the Board of Trustees, the PTA Country Fair Organising Group and the Staff. We all love the Country Fair and are understandably proud of its history and its place in the Whangarei City Events calendar. However, the uncertainty around Covid Levels and the amount of time, energy and effort that goes into organising the day mean that it is not practical for 2020. We want everyone to pencil in Saturday 6 November, 2021 for the next fantastic, mesmerising and funfilled family day which is the Maunu School Country Fair 2021.

Teacher Only Day: School is closed for students this Monday, 31st August for a Staff Professional Development Day. The staff will be involved in professional development that includes Literacy; Positive Behaviours; Well Being; Cultural Responsiveness; Te Reo and Tikanga Maori. End of Year Date: There has been some delay in finalising exactly when we will finish school this year, due to the change in term dates for term 1 (under Level 4 & 3) and now the cancellation of Country Fair (considered a school day). School will now close for students at 3pm on Monday 14th December. On Monday 14th we will hold the final assembly, beginning at 11am. Later in the day, children will gather with their 2021 teacher and classmates. The Tuesday will be a Staff Development Day, with final planning for 2021. School is closed for students on this day.

2021 Dates: The changes to the 2020 term dates has an impact on the length of the Christmas break. Schools are bound to adhere to dates as set out by the Ministry of Education. The earliest the school can open in 2021 is Monday 1 February, and the latest is Tuesday 9 February. The start date impacts on the finish date and is determined by the number of days we must be open during the year - 190 days. A decision on the start date for 2021 will be made as soon as possible. The delay is somewhat unavoidable with the changes that have occurred this year.
