USE OF KIWISPORT FUNDING AT MAUNU SCHOOL IN 2019

The kiwisport funding at Maunu School has been used to assist funding for various projects.

- A Perceptual Motor Programme was provided to children in Years One, Two and Three, plus some older children who exhibited some lack of coordination. This programme was part of the Junior Team teaching and learning programme and was coordinated by a teacher.
- 2. We continued with an athletics day, which was set up with other schools involving our children participating in our own athletics day, then some children going on to a zone event and then an area event.
- 3. We had Rugby league coaches, Hockey programmes, Cricket coaching & Rippa Rugby that involved lessons for children across the school.
- 4. Sports exchanges with other schools and attendance at various tournaments, were held with a number of different sports involved, rippa rugby, netball, soccer.
- 5. Sports (House) competitions are run at lunchtime involving children from across the school.
- 6. PAL sports held twice weekly at lunchtimes. These are coordinated by student leaders.
- 7. Sports events and activities are promoted and the school grounds are made accessible to sports groups and the public.
