I am sure you have noticed the extra buildings now on site - and the extra fencing!!! As part of the build, the sewer line had to be re-routed so that it was clear of the building on the field side of the school. It is a messy time of year to have this work done and the contractors are doing their best to minimise the damage to the grounds. This project is managed by the MoE, not the school. The expected completion date is before the beginning of term 3, but that may be dependent on weather and availability of materials. The rooms will have decks in front and ramp access. There will also be concrete areas in front of both classrooms. These are roll growth classrooms to cope with the growth in the Maunu area.

With the wet weather and the restriction on the ground usage, please make sure there is a change of clothes in your child's bag in case they end up wet and muddy. They will not be able to go into the classrooms if they are, so a change would be a good idea.

Thank you to those who came along and supported the PTA organised Disco on Friday night. We appreciate the efforts of the PTA in putting on these events for the children of Maunu School. With the large numbers of children now attending it is a bit of a logistical conundrum and the support of parents is crucial. A special thanks to the PTA people who set up, sizzled sausages and organised the night.

By the time you receive this we will have held our mathathon day. This day was to raise the profile, awareness and focus on mathematics. The children were involved in class activities, buddy class times and "mathex" type activities.
