Here are some ideas of how to set your day up if your child is working at home. Please adapt these to suit your circumstances and routine.

Each family will have their own way of working through the day. However it is important to try and maintain some structure to the day and make sure your children are active where possible.



Time	Activity	Description
Before 9am	Wake up Morning chores	Get dressed, make bed, tidy room, breakfast
9.00 - 10.00	Morning walk Outside play/activity	Family walk or exercise
10.00 - 11.00	Scheduled academic time	A balance of electronic and non-electronic study Eg: flash cards, board games, reading, maths, inquiry tasks (set by school and/or home)
11.00 - 12.00	Creative time	Lego, art, music, baking etc
12.00 - 1.00	Lunch Exercise	
1.00 - 2.00	Chill time	Reading, puzzles, device if allowed etc
2.00 - 3.30	Scheduled academic time	A balance of electronic and non-electronic study On-line programme from school - maths activities, reading activities, spelling, written language etc
