1.00 - 2.00	Chill Time	Reading, puzzles, device if allowed etc
2.00 - 3.30	Scheduled Academic Time	A balance of electronic and non-electronic study On-line programme from school, PRIME other maths activities, Reading activities, Spelling, Written Language etc
