Before 9am	Wake up; Morning chores	Get dressed, make bed, tidy room, breakfast
9.00 - 10.00	Morning Walk; Outside play/activity	Family walk or exercise
10.00 - 11.00	Scheduled Academic Time	A balance of Electronic and non-electronic study Eg: Sudoku, flash cards, board games, reading, maths, writing
11.00 - 12.00	Creative Time	Lego; Art; Music; baking etc
12.00 - 1.00	Lunch & exercise	
1.00 - 2.00	Chill Time	Reading, puzzles, device if allowed etc
2.00 - 3.30	Scheduled Academic Time	A balance of Electronic and non-electronic study On-line activities from school - maths activities, reading activities, spelling, written language etc
