Spring is fast approaching and with hopefully some warmer days and less rain! I hope you have managed to get through the recent weather events without too much damage. Our thoughts are with those families throughout Tai Tokerau and the rest of New Zealand who have experienced serious damage to property and disruption to their lives.

Cross Country: It was great to be able to get across to Barge Park on Wednesday 24th August for our school Cross Country. Thank you to all those who gave up their time to help out on the course and around the finish line. With a change of course this year, we needed people to help direct the children. We did find that our times were a little different and we have learnt from that for next year, so we don't get any crossover of races. Congratulations to all the children who started the races. The first goal is to be involved, even if cross country is not "your thing". Your courage, persistence and hard work are to be commended. Finishing the course is also a goal, unless you get injured or have something happen along the way. We cannot all be first, but we can all be winners. To those who won their races or placed in the top 10 - well done!! It is always important to push yourself to achieve your best. If you were selected to represent the school at the WPSSA & Northland Cross Country Championships - congratulations. Remember, you have been selected to compete with the best, because you are one of the best!!

Kapa Haka: We are very proud of the kapa haka roopu and the levels they achieve. We thank Matua Shane (Maunsell Tutors) for his continued input and support. It is important for our tamariki to understand that kapa haka is part of a wider cultural understanding and is part of te ao Maori. As such, the sessions will often spend time on the reasons behind the waiata and the actions. It is also important that those attending the kapa haka sessions put in the time to practice in between the weekly sessions. We have had a disrupted time over the past 2 years, with limited opportunities to perform in public, but we need to remember that the performance is only one aspect of kapa haka. Coming up we have the Mangakahia Area School festival (10th November) and another possible performance in November, along with the Country Fair - 5th November.

Notifying the school of student notices: When you need to change an arrangement for your child or notify the school that your child is sick, please make all communications through the school office. There have been cases where parents have emailed the teacher during the day, and this is not appropriate. Teachers may be away at PD, or sick and I do not expect them to be checking emails during the day. 
