Greetings to you all; tena koutou katoa;

New long-term strategy for COVID-19 - Impact for Maunu School

You'll be aware that New Zealand has moved to a new, long-term approach to COVID-19. These changes have been made based on public health advice and reflect high levels of immunity and declining case numbers across New Zealand. This new approach will only result in minor changes to the way we operate at Maunu School.

COVID -19 Infection: If a child has COVID-19, they are still required to isolate for 7 days before returning to school. We ask that you contact the school if your child does test positive, so we can maintain our records and ensure we meet our health and safety measures.

Household Contact: The very positive news is that household contacts of a person with COVID-19 do not need to isolate. We recommend and encourage that they complete a RAT test each day, for five days. Therefore, any child who is a household contact but tests negative and does not have COVID-19 symptoms, should continue to attend school. It is the best place for them to be so they can be engaged in their learning, and connected with their teachers, classmates and friends. Mask wearing is no longer required, however, anyone who wishes to continue to wear a mask is encouraged to do so.

All the other recommended public health measures will stay in place as we know they reduce the spread of infectious illnesses including COVID-19. These include ensuring our indoor spaces are well-ventilated, maintaining good hand hygiene, encouraging everyone to cough or sneeze into elbows and, most importantly, staying home and getting tested if they have COVID-19 symptoms.

Thank you for your ongoing support in protecting our community. This term we have had very few cases of COVID-19, but lots of cases of 'flu and

other winter illnesses. Bring on Spring and the warmer weather.

Public Holiday: Maunu School will be closed on Monday 26th September, in line with the Government declaring a public holiday for Queen Elizabeth II Memorial Day

School Board: Following the recent board elections, we welcome two new members to the Maunu School Board - Charlotte Smith and Yvette Ferreira-Botha, who join Alison Manson, Todd Leathem and Rachel Wright who were re-elected. We look forward to a productive, effective and collaborative working relationship with the new board. The board is an integral part of Maunu School and it has been an absolute pleasure working with the board over the last 6 years. We farewell Phil Currey and Kate Davies, who have stepped down after 6 years of amazingly positive contributions. Thank you both for everything you have been involved in over your time.
