2023 Staffing: As stated in a school app announcement on Wednesday 16 November, Courtney de Boer has been appointed to a Deputy Principal's position at Maunu School beginning in 2023. We congratulate Courtney on this appointment and welcome her to Maunu School. Courtney comes to us from Otaika Valley School. I know you will take the time to meet Courtney and welcome her to the Maunu community. I apologise for a few omissions in the last newsletter in relation to staffing for 2023: Whaea Claudine will be taking Reading Recovery and Tikanga & Te Reo Maori; Lynne will be looking after the Library and taking on some teacher aide roles and Kaytlyn Sykes will be working in the senior syndicate.

School Pool: After a year of Covid and building projects, we are now getting the school pool ready for swimming and to be open for Maunu School families for the summer break. We will be selling keys at \$120 per key (only 1 per family), with a \$20 refund on return of the key at the end of the swimming season in Term 1 2023. The pool keys are initially available to Maunu School families who are fully paid up on all fees etc. There is an agreement that must be signed before a key will be given out and it is essential that all rules are abided by. We have Northern District Security monitoring the pool and we ask any key holder to ring them if they see behaviour that is not within our Values, or people who are abusing the key rules or who do not have a key. The pool is cleaned daily, so is not open for use until 10am each day. Carolyn will be putting something out when we have keys available, as we have had to get new ones cut.

Beginning of the school day: School officially starts at 8.55am. Children should arrive between 8.15am and 8.50am so they are prepared for the day. Staff often have meetings in the morning and are not always in their rooms until after 8.15am. We have children arriving at 7.30am which is not acceptable as it places the child in a risk situation. It is also worth noting that when children are late on a

regular basis it has an impact on their learning and their socialisation.

**2023 Enrolments:** If you know of any children, new entrants or older, who live in the Maunu area and are not already enrolled at Maunu School, can you please either contact the school office or ask the family to contact us. It makes planning for classes and staffing very difficult when we have children arrive who have been in the area but we do not know about.
