#### **Community Pharmacy Minor Ailments Service**

What is the Minor Ailments Service (MAS)?

It is a service that is provided by community pharmacies to consult on a range of minor health onditions and supply medicines and treatment aids if clinically indicated.

Promoted as the 'Community Pharmacy Minor Health Conditions Service', the initiative aims to improve access for people who are unable to access care or afford care for these minor ailments.

Consistent with the health sector principle in section 7(e)(i) of the Pae Ora (Healthy Futures) Act 2023, MAS also promotes people's health and wellbeing by helping to prevent, reduce, or delay the onset of health needs

What conditions are covered under the Minor Ailments Service?

· Acute diarrhoea, and Dehydration (e.g. due to vomiting or diarrhoea

- Eve infections and inflammation
- Pain and fever

Scabies

Headlice

Eczema/dermatitis

Minor skin infections

Who is eligible to receive the service?

A person is eligible to receive the service if they have a condition covered by MAS (set out under uestion 6 below), they are eligible for publicly funded health services in NZ, and they are one of the following:

a child under 14 years of age;

a whanau member (any age) of a child under 14 years of age, with the same symptoms;

a holder of a Community Service Card (CSC), or the dependent child of a CSC holder and is 14 to 17 ears of age; or

a Mãori and Pacific person.

Will people need to book an appointment for a consultation?

harmacies may offer bookable appointments for MAS, however the priority is that all participating pharmacies can also accept 'walk-in' patients in their usual manner.
